


Louisiana Seat Belt Use Rate


What percentage of Louisiana adults drove under the influence of alcohol in past 12 months?



"the perceived capability to derive pathways to desired goals and motivate oneself via agency thinking to use those pathways."


- Willingness to move forward (the will)


